## SHOULD I CALL 999 FOR INFORMATION OR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FOR CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)?



No. The 999 number is for medical emergencies requiring immediate medical attention and transfer to an emergency department. The Ambulance Service's Medical Dispatchers receive hundreds of 999 calls each day from members of the public with urgent medical conditions and the 999 number must be prioritized for these life-threatening situations.
